For the safety of all our communities, general public and school audiences will be separated for the time being and we ask all guests to take their seats 5 minutes before curtain up.

Your visit

- 1. For online bookings, we ask that you print your order confirmation email and show this on entry. This will avoid unnecessary handling of tickets, reduce the need for queuing at our box office and reduce contact time with our front of house team.
- 2. In line with Oundle School's Visitors Policy, we politely ask you to undertake an LFD home test within 24 hours prior to your visit and continue to observe good hand and respiratory hygiene throughout your visit.
- 3. Please scan the 'Test and Trace' barcode on entry
- 4. Please keep your belongings on you and to a minimum where possible. No hangers will be available for coats to avoid transmission.
- 5. Please maintain social distancing and wear face coverings where possible

Our commitment to you

- 1. We clean the venue before every event, concentrating on high touch points. We also regularly fog and disinfect the building.
- 2. Our Front of House team will be wearing face coverings and all staff are voluntarily taking bi-weekly lateral flow tests to keep you, and each other, safe.
- 3. Hand sanitiser stations will be available throughout the building

- You have tested positive or are showing COVID-19 symptoms and are currently waiting for test results.
